Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship Guidelines

Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary scholarship is available for high school seniors pursuing a certification, degree or licensure in the health care field the first year after high school graduation.

Applicants for this \$1,000 scholarship require completion of a Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship application which outlines the applicant's interest/activities along with their class rank, GPA and graduation date. Applicants will be required to submit an essay titled "Why I chose to pursue a career in the health profession."

Stipulations for the scholarships are as follows:

- 1. Applicants must plan on attending a college and/or university to pursue a certification, degree or licensure in the health care field.*
- 2. Applicants must be in the top 1/3 of their class.
- 3. Applicants must plan to pursue a career in the health care field.
- 4. Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary scholarship is to be paid for tuition only.

Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary scholarship applicants will be reviewed by the scholarship committee. Each applicant will be interviewed by the scholarship committee. The scholarship committee will discuss all interviews and determine the scholarship recipient.

Recipient will be awarded a certificate indicating they are the winner of the Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship at their scholarship awards program. The recipient will be required to submit the name and address of the college and/or university they will be attending, along with their transcript to the scholarship committee. Five hundred dollars (\$500) is sent directly to the recipient's college and/or university for the first semester. At the end of the first semester, the recipient will have an interview with the scholarship committee before the second \$500 is forwarded to the recipient's college and/or university. At the end of the second semester, the recipient is asked to report to the scholarship committee on his/her progress.

All applications are to be returned to the high school counselor by April 1, 2015.

*As long as the A+ program is in effect at North Central Missouri College, students applying for the Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship who will be attending North Central Missouri College through the A+ program will not be eligible for the Wright Memorial Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship.
